She became Projects Coordinator (moving Voices) in March 2009. moving Voices is a volunteer dance project, recruiting 3,218 young people aged 16 -25 over three years from nine counties, to lead their own youth dance committees, plan and deliver dance activities and teach dance to people in their communities.
