Festival Regulations

South East Dance is looking for the best new dance film and video made specifically for the camera and shot for the big screen, for screening at Dance for Camera Festival 2007. If you have a dance film or video made from October 2005 to date, which is under 30 minutes in length, and from any country, which you would like considered for inclusion in our festival, please submit your film to us.

Programmes can be entered by filmmakers, artists, distributors, broadcasters, producers, production companies and dance companies.

There is no limit to the number of films entered per organisation/individual.

Festival applicants whose films are selected for screening give permission to the organisers to; use the 2 high quality images from your film; use an excerpt of the selected film not exceeding 30 seconds; change and write copy for the film in our festival brochure for promotional purposes, free of charge and free of any claims.

As part of our commitment to excellence we encourage diversity amongst practitioners and audiences for screen dance.

Application

To ensure proper processing of your application it is important that the application process be followed correctly and that all requested materials be received by the South East Dance office by the closing date at the latest.

Deadline for entry is Friday 31 August.

- South East Dance will pay a one off screening fee to applicants whose films are selected for inclusion in the festival.
- All entrants must hold the rights to agree distribution of the entered film.
- Preview copies will not be returned unless a SAE is supplied on entry.
- Entries may also be considered for other screening opportunities.
- South East Dance retain the right to change and write copy for the film in our festival brochure

By completing and sending the application form to South East Dance, the applicant accepts responsibility for this application and agrees to the festival regulations.

Shipping Instructions

All materials should be shipped pre-paid either:

For packages coming from non-EU countries, please note that packages must be accompanied by a value declaration covering tape stock, as well as a customs declaration stating that the video materials are sent for non-commercial festival use only.
