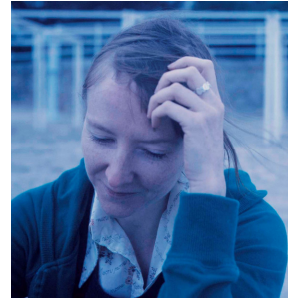


Lucy Cash

South East Dance Associate Artist



Lucy Cash is an interdisciplinary artist and choreographer.

Originally from a background in performance, she began her career as an artist with a New Director's Award from the BFI / FilmFour. Since then she has made artists' film and video projects for gallery exhibition and site specific spaces, as well as single screen films, radio, and live performance. Her work has been shown on television (Ch4, Filmfour, BBC4 and BBC2) and in gallery spaces and at festivals both internationally and within the UK.

In addition to recent solo work, many of her projects have been and still are collaborative. Between 2000 - 2009 she was an associate member of Goat Island, working on both performance and film projects. Other collaborations include: Rajni Shah Theatre, Christina Ciupke / Nik Haffner, Litó Walkey, Mark Jeffery / Judd Morrissey, Anna Krzystek, and Gerard Bell.

This year her work has included a collaboration with choreographer Christina Ciupke - *From The Other Side* (www.christinaciupke.com) which will be shown at Sophiensale, Berlin in February 2010. As well as a week long series of performance installations (with Swiss artist Tabea Martin) *Everything That Happens Here Happens here Today* which showed at the Operaestate Festival in Bassano, Italy (www.lucycash.com/collaborations.html). A new film installation - *A Last, A Quartet* will be shown at the Peter Scott Gallery, Lancaster in November 2009. Also this year, she is one of four artists working on Artist Bank for the Siobhan Davies Studios as well as research artist for Transitions company.

In 2009 - 2010 she is a Screen Dance Fellow with South East Dance and since 2007 she has been an Associate Artist with Artsadmin.
