



DANCE FOR CAMERA SHORTS 2008

Technical Specification

The collection consists of nine dance works for the screen on two DVDs which are intended to be projected on a screen. The DVD marked DVD1 is to be played first and will last approximately 32 minutes. After the first DVD has played, there can be an interval, the length of which will be decided by the individual venue. After the interval, the second DVD marked DVD2 can be played. This will last approximately 37 minutes.

The total duration of this collection is: approx. 65 mins.

To present the collection you will need to provide the following facilities:

- A screening room/ studio/ cinema with blackout, in this space you will need: a data projector, a projection screen (of an appropriate size for the space), a stereo sound system (preferably 5.1 surround), a DVD player and appropriate cabling.

Please note: the technician must make themselves familiar with the format of the DVDs prior to the screening; to familiarise themselves with how the programme plays; to check that the discs play correctly and that all sound levels are at their optimum for the screening space.
